WHAT IS JETSTREAM2?


- Jetstream2 is a flexible, user-friendly cloud computing environment
- Offering customizable virtual machines ("instances"), cloud storage, and more
- Funded by the NSF
- Available to any US-based researcher or educator for free

WHY SHOULD YOU USE JETSTREAM2?

- Full sudo/admin access to choose your operating system and install software you need
- Broad range of resource "flavors" including Large Memory and NVIDIA vGPU slicing
- Available on demand without sharing or queues, and no runtime limit
- Persistent public IPs and full internet access
- Free to use through our support from the National Science Foundation and ACCESS





WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH JETSTREAM2?

- Receive and analyze data on a powerful virtual workstation
- Write, debug, and execute code with interactive GUI applications
- Host dedicated, private runners for CI/CD pipelines
- Train, refine, and run machine learning models with GPUs
- Share your applications via static or dynamic website/gateway
